3- WAY SCHOLARSHIP MATCH APPLICATION

*Applicants must reapply each semester

A 3-way scholarship is a plan whereby the student's family or students earnings, the student's church/concerned person(s), and Southwestern Adventist University funds help meet the student's expenses. This scholarship is intended to help students who, <u>after applying for Federal/State grants and loans</u>, and <u>after consideration of expected earnings from work</u>, are short of meeting University expenses.

It is the responsibility of the student to obtain a commitment from outside sources. Southwestern Adventist University will match these funds up to \$500.00 after determining that the student <u>qualifies</u> for the SWAU match. Application for these funds does <u>not</u> mean automatic approval of the SWAU matching portion. If additional aid is received after the 3-way has been awarded causing an over-award on Federal Student Aid, adjustments will be made to the student's aid awards. This could include reduction in loan awards and/or loss of the SWAU 3-way match. This is a need-based scholarship and th student:

*All 3-Way Money Due:

- Student may not be a recipient of educational subsidy.
- Student must first apply for Federal/State grants and loans.
- Student has unmet expenses after all other aid and earnings from work.
- Student has unmet need as determined by the federal aid calculation
- SWAU match will not exceed the lower of the two committed amounts.
